Pedagogic/teaching methodology:

Scheduled learning includes lectures and discussions. In one class, all the students are divided into small groups. Each group has to discuss the topic determined by the lecturer and presents the results to the class.

Lecturers present module materials using the LCD and whiteboard.

Independent learning includes hours engaged with essential reading, assignment preparation and completion and self-directed study.

Assessments used:

There are three types of assessment:

- 1. Middle examination (40%)
- 2. Final examination (40%)
- 3. Group/individual assignment (20%)

Each examination takes 100 minutes including multiple choice questions, essays, and short answer questions. Assignment is assessed by writing a report about a specific case then the students present it. The examination assesses the students' knowledge and understanding and all learning outcomes of the module.
